Short lived in the annals of *The Official Guide*, the *Arizona Limited* was a first class, lightweight, steam-powered luxury train operated by Rock Island - Southern Pacific between Chicago and Phoenix over the Golden State Route. Closely resembling the *49er*, the *Arizona Limited* departed from its terminals every other day between December 15th and April 3rd during the winter seasons of 1940-1942 at which time it became a casualty of World War II.
